A community Landcare Group is a group regardless of legal status that enables people to come together, share knowledge and experiences and carry out positive, practical activities for the long term health of our natural environment.

These groups may be formal or informal groups. Some examples of groups in the Territory include incorporated urban Landcare groups, pastoral Landcare groups, Indigenous Ranger groups, Friends of groups, Coastcare, Bushcare and Rivercare groups.
